



Dan Sweeney's One Hit Wonders Fact Sheet

- Weekly. Each show runs 55-57-minutes.
- FREE to air
- Two Categories (60+ episodes each):
 - 1955-1985
 - 1985- 2015
- Description:
 - One Hit Wonders music by year. Information and trivia related to each song including where the artist is born and raised, interesting facts leading up to the hit, and “where are they now”. Also, news events/trivia from each year, artist interviews and featuring a Movie trailer from each year.
 - A One Hit Wonder is a combination of artist and song that makes it into the Billboard Hot 100 Top 40 once and never repeats the achievement again.
- Special shows:
 - Summertime One Hit Wonders- 1 or 2-hour shows- One Hit Wonders from 1955-2015 during each summer month (June, July, August).
 - New Years Eve One Hit Wonders- 2-hour show- One Hit Wonders from 1955-2015 around the new year.
 - This Week in One Hit Wonders- A weekly 1-hour show. Time specific (e.g. 1st week of Jan, when the song peaked in the Billboard Top 40. Two categories: 1955-1985; 1985-2015. Starting in January 2020.
- The shows are non-commercial. Dan Sweeney's One Hit Wonders reserves the right to insert 2 minutes of time for underwriting. Station agrees to supply stream data results.
- Each show is made available on Monday of the week of broadcast.
- Each show also comes with 2 song/artist summaries, poster art and YouTube video link for social media use.
